- 7. Define the concept population resource region. Identify its parameters and describe the population resource regions of the world as suggested by Ackerman.

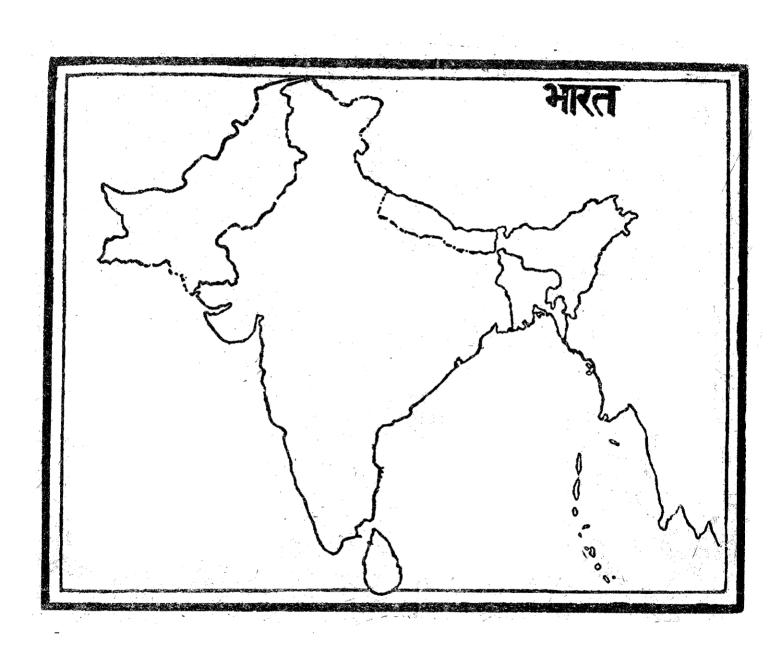
